Important update: Carriage of Firearms within FedEx-TNT network

Dear [REDACTED],

As we progress with FedEx-TNT integration, we are continuing to align TNT operations and transportation policies to FedEx Express.

Effective from 9 August 2021, we will cease the transportation of firearms¹, weaponry and ammunition² in both our Domestic and International networks.

We will continue to ship accessories associated with firearms, subject to our standard acceptance of Dangerous Goods and Conditions of Carriage. FedEx-TNT holds the right to accept or reject these shipments based on the suitability within our network.

Please be reminded that it is important to properly declare all items to avoid any delays and cancellations to your shipment. Any movement of undeclared firearms, weaponry and ammunition shipments in our network may be deemed undeliverable and subject to further action. FedEx-TNT reserves the right to suspend or cancel accounts found to ship undeclared firearms, weaponry and ammunition.

¹ This includes but is not limited to the transportation of: firearms, weaponry and their parts (including anything that can be used to construct firearms); handguns such as pistols, rifles, shotguns (centre fire, rim fire and black powder firearms); firearms under the firearms act manufactured pre 1900 and to which commercial grade ammunition is unavailable; air guns such as air pistols and air rifles; replica firearms including ghost guns and other firearms not containing a serial number; gel blasters; toy imitation firearms; paintball guns; BB guns; bump fire stocks and other rapid-fire trigger activators; any firearm or other weapon manufacture using a 3-D printing machine.

² This refers to all kinds of ammunition and their components, including projectiles, primers, powders, shell casings and air rifle pellets.
